How To Reduce Fire Hazards "Creating Defensible Space"

- □ Remove brush, weeds, dry grass, needles, leaves and any other flammable vegetation within 30 feet of any structure (or to property line).
- □ Additional clearance up to 100 feet (or to property line) may be needed to protect homes near brush fields and/or wooded areas.
- Maintain trees, shrubs or bushes adjacent to or overhanging any structure clear of dead limbs.
- Prune trees so that no limb is within 10 feet of any chimney opening. A 1/2 inch maximum mesh screen is required for all chimney outlets.

- ☐ Maintain roof, gutters and deck surfaces free of leaves, needles, twigs and any combustible materials.
- ☐ All brush, weeds, grass and hazardous vegetation within 10 feet of any road.
- ☐ Clear all vegetation, trash or other combustible material a minimum of 10 feet from propane tanks or containers.
- → Remove all cut vegetation and combustible debris and dispose of it in a legal and safe manner.

Brush Clearance and Maintenance Is A Year Round Responsibility
